The July *Guess that Plant* a non-native plant that has become part of New Jersey's flora. Chicory is a member of the Asteraceae, is a native to Europe, but is now established in North America, China and Australia. This plant is a morning flowerer, with its best display is before mid-day. The flowers fade and close in the afternoon. This plant is found throughout the State, in roadside and open field habitats, and is a common urban weedy perennial.
