

The September *Guess that Plant* was ***Biden bidentoides*, Swamp Beggars Tick.**

This wetland plant is restricted within the FNJ region to the tidal shores of the Hudson, Raritan and Delaware Rivers, where it occupies a narrow niche between the high tide line and non-tidal environments.

It is a globally rare plant that is restricted to our Northern North American estuaries (Chesapeake, Delaware and Hudson).

It has an annual growth strategy that allows the plant to move with the tides and establish wherever open muddy habitats form within the freshwater portions of these importance Atlantic Coast tidal systems.
