

2014 June *Guess that Plant*



Geranium carolinianum L., Carolina Geranium

The June *Guess That Plant* was native geranium that exists scattered throughout the state. Carolina geranium grows on rich, open to shaded upland soils. It differs from our other *Geranium* species by having the flower pedicel equal or shorter than the calyx and its light pink corolla.

Mary Hough (1983) documents the plant from nearly every county, and those without specimens probably support the plant as well.
