

2016 July *Guess that Plant*



Arenaria serpyllifolia L., Thyme-leaf Sandwort

The July *Guess that Plant* was a little weedy annual often seen in open disturbed areas, lawns and fields. *Arenaria serpyllifolia* is a member of the Pink family, the Caryophyllaceae. Thyme leaved sandwort is found throughout the State, with Mary Hough (1983) documenting specimens from all counties except the southwestern corner of the State. Observations of this plant in Gloucester and Salem Counties indicates its presence in this region as well.
